

Subject:**Pall Industrial Statement concerning SDS and PSDS documentation supplied by Pall Corporation.****General Information on PFASs:**

Pall Corporation generate 'Safety Data Sheets' (SDS) to provide its customers, warehousing and shippers and anyone interacting with item, with information on its chemical composition, its safe handling, storage, emergency measures and disposal - where the item is a chemical 'substance' or a 'mixture'. Where they are defined as:

Substance - comprises a single chemical compound.

Mixture - comprises two or more chemical compounds.

To ensure that the most up to date SDS information is available to users on global chemicals, English language format copies are available at any time at <https://www.pall.com/en/about-pall/quality/ssdi.html>, alongside which is a button for users to request copies of further documents or translations to local requirements / language.

However, most Pall Corporation products are not considered to be substances or mixtures, but rather 'articles', Where they are defined as:

Article - an item where the physical form is more important than the material from which it is made, e.g., filter cartridge, filter housing or assembly.

and most are made from non-hazardous materials, do not include transportation fluids or separate chemicals. Where the article is made from hazardous materials or has an associated chemical present such as a transportation fluid, or separate purification material, an SDS shall be available from Pall for that chemical component present. Please contact Pall for more details.

For non-hazardous articles Pall Corporation is not required to provide SDS documents. However, Pall Corporation has chosen to provide information to assist users in their safe handling, storage, emergency measures and disposal too on a number of items. These documents are to a Pall internal format, but reflect common themes in SDS formats, and can be found at <https://www.pall.com/en/about-pall/quality/psdi.html>.
